The beaches and oceans are an important natural attraction of the tropical Far North Queensland region. Many species of jelly fish can be found in the oceans of this part of the world. Two of these species, the Chironex Box Jelly Fish and the Irukandji, are classed as dangerous tropical jellyfish. (marine stingers) During the warmer months potentially dangerous marine stingers are present in tropical waters. It is very important to take the necessary precautions to minimise the associated risks.
