Pollution Trail Lesson Plan

Equipment

- Gloves and bucket, shared amongst students depending on group size
- Sharps container
- Whale display (optional)
- Germany whale stranding document (optional)
- Ocean plastic document (optional)
- Tangaroa Blue Marine Debris Manual (optional)
- Discussion in appropriate area about what pollution is and why it is an issue – vary according to student's needs.
- 2. Ensure students are aware of specific hazards, glass, sharps and cigarette butts.
- 3. Define area to be used for litter collecting and requirements to stay with groups.
- Return to under cover area and sort litter into various categories, recyclables, plastics, landfill etc.
- 5. Discuss and reflect results with students based upon student needs.
